New Chairperson for the PUG – Trenton Greive was introduced as the new Chairperson for the Cunderdin Project User Group, replacing Bev Hamerton. Trenton is the WA Country Health Operations Manager for the Western Wheatbelt region, however Bev will continue to be involved in the project as a part of the team designing the new health centre and developing new services.

Floorplan of Cunderdin Health Centre – The floor plan for the new health centre is complete and the design has been approved by all users. The PUG had a chance to review the plan and provided feedback from a community perspective.

The next phase of design kicks off on the 22 June; placing the furniture, fittings and equipment in each room.

Health Services - A new 6 month action plan has been developed to further progress the primary health model of service. More information is to come as the action plan goals and strategies are finalised.
