LOCAL GOVERNMENT PROPERTY AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2016

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of Cunderdin resolved on 18th February 2016 to adopt the following local law.

1. Citation

This local law is cited as the *Shire of Cunderdin Local Government Property Amendment Local Law 2016*.

2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation fourteen days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3 Principal local law

In this local law, the *Shire of Cunderdin Local Government Property Local Law 2015* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 15 May 2015 is referred to as the principal local law. The principal local law is amended as follows.

4. Clause 4.6 amended

Clause 4.6 is amended by deleting subclause (1) and replacing with-


- (1) An authorised person may refuse to allow entry, or suspend admission, to a specific venue of local government property except for the venue where local government council meetings are held, by any person who he or she believes has behaved in a manner contrary to the provisions of this Part.
