CCTV Funding Secured



The Shire of Cunderdin is pleased to have secured funding through the Western Australian Government's 2026 CCTV Grant Program to expand the CCTV network across Cunderdin and Meckering.

Additional CCTV and ANPR cameras will be installed at priority locations identified in consultation with WA Police, helping to improve surveillance, deter crime and support local Police investigations.

COUNCIL MEETING

Highlights



Ordinary Meetings of Council are held on the fourth Wednesday of each month, (excluding January and December, in which the meeting is held on the third Wednesday due to the Christmas period). Meetings commence at 6pm in the Shire's Council Chambers located at the Administration Office. Council receive reports and recommendations at meetings covering a range of topics crucial to the development and governance actions for the Shire.

Following are a medley of recent items deliberated by Council:

AUGUST 2026

Local Law Review - Pest Plants Local Law 2015

Council noted one submission received during the public advertising period, however resolved to retain the Local Law in its current form as presented.

Local Law Review - Animals, Environment and Nuisance Local Law 2016

Council noted that no submissions were received during the public advertising period and noted the resolution of the April 2020 Ordinary Council Meeting to approve the suspension of Part 4, Division 2, Section 4.4 of the Local Law, subject to legal advice. They resolved that the motion lay on the table for consideration at the September 2026 Council Meeting, pending further information.

Regional Housing Fund - Stakeholder Group

Following the fund received for the construction of 5 new units at Sandalwood Village, Council have resolved to establish a Stakeholder Working Group for the Age Friendly Community Housing Project. It will consist of two Councillors, two Cunderdin Meckering Cottage Homes representatives and three Shire Administration Team members.

The next Ordinary Council Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, 29 September 2026, at 6:00pm in the Cunderdin Shire Council Chambers.

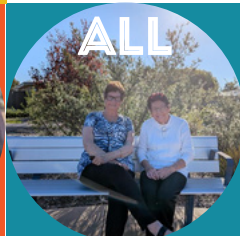
