# COUNCIL MEETING

## Highlights



Ordinary Meetings of Council are held on the fourth Wednesday of each month, (excluding January and December, in which the meeting is held on the third Wednesday due to the Christmas period). Meetings commence at 6pm in the Shire's Council Chambers located at the Administration Office.

Council receive reports and recommendations at meetings covering a range of topics crucial to the development and governance actions for the Shire.

Following are a medley of recent items deliberated by Council:

## JUNE 2026

### **Request to Initiate Review of Local Laws**

- Council resolved to initiate a review of the Shire of Cunderdin's Local Laws.
- Local Public Notice was advertised 18 June 2026 requesting submissions from the community with feedback on the existing local laws, to be received by the 31 July 2026.

### **Audit, Risk and Improvement Committee - Appointment of Independent Presiding Member:**

- On 1 January 2026, it became a requirement of Local Governments to transfer their *Audit Committees* into "*Audit, Risk and Improvement Committees*", with changes to be implemented by 30 June 2026.
- One of the new requirements is to have an Independent Presiding Member and Independent Deputy Presiding Member.
- Council appointed Mrs Pauline Smart as the Independent Presiding Member and Mr Nic Warren as the Deputy Independent Presiding Member.

### **Disaster Ready Funding - Round 4**

- The Australian Government's Disaster Ready Funding (DRF) provides funding for projects that strengthen community resilience and reduce the risk and impact of natural disasters.
- WEROC (comprising of the Shire's of Cunderdin, Tammin, Kellerberrin, Merredin, Westonia, Southern Cross, Bruce Rock & Cunderdin) is coordinating a joint application for funding.
- Council supported the joint application.

### **Adoption of Age Friendly Plan, Public Health Plan and Integrated Strategic Plan**

- Following extensive community engagement workshops, surveys and a public advertisement period of 3 weeks, the above plans were adopted by Council.
- They can be found on the Shires Website under "Integrated Planning Documents"

### **Receive minutes of the Local Emergency Management Committee Meeting (LEMC)**

- A LEMC Meeting was held 10 June 2026, which was a desktop exercise run by the CESM.

### **Amendment to Five Year Plan - Regional Road Group (RRG) Roads**

- Council's 5 Year RRG Road Plan was put forward with a request to amend, due to the lack of available gravel in the area.
- The change saw that Moore Road (27/28 - 29/30) be replaced with Carter-Doodenanning Road.

### **Next Meeting:**

The next Ordinary Council Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, 22 July 2026, at 6:00 PM in the Cunderdin Shire Council Chambers.

## Local Law Review

Section 3.16 the *Local Government Act 1995* requires that all local laws must be reviewed within a 15-year period after their commencement to determine if they should remain unchanged, be repealed, or amended. The 15-year period is taken to be from either when the local law commenced or when the last review of the local law was completed.

As part of the Local Government reforms and implementation of the *Local Government Amendment Act 2024*, the Shire of Cunderdin is now required to review all local laws within a two-year period, prior to 7 December 2026, unless a review occurred within the last 8 years.

At the Ordinary Meeting of Council on 17 June 2026, Council approved to review the Shire of Cunderdin's local laws by a suitable timeframe. The following laws are being reviewed and are open for public comment:

A copy of the local laws are available on the Shire's website ([Local Laws » Shire of Cunderdin](#)) or can be viewed at the Shire Administration Office, 37 Lundy Avenue, Cunderdin.

The outcomes of the review will be presented to Council with recommendations on any amendments to the Shire's local laws, which may be required. This process will confirm the 'purpose' and 'effect' of each local law and include a 'proposed draft' local law, which will then be advertised for a statutory period of 42 days to allow for any public comments, and together with a copy of the 'proposed draft' local law this will be forwarded to the relevant Ministers.

The Shire of Cunderdin invites public submissions. Your feedback will be reviewed and presented to Council when considering if these local laws are to remain unchanged, repealed or amended.

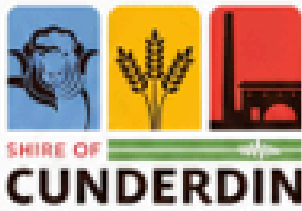
