We can't wait for you to get to know Kay and join us in giving her a warm welcome!

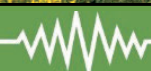

PROJECTS UPDATE

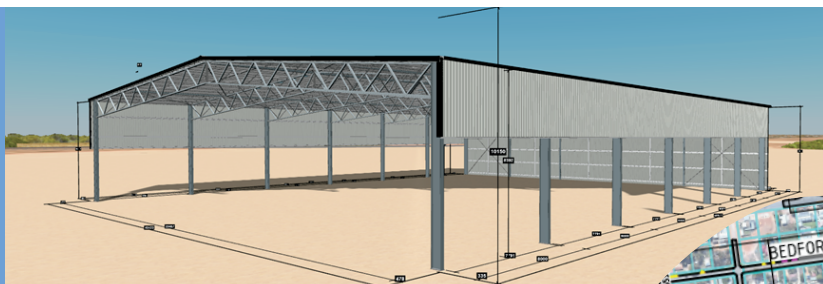
SEPTEMBER 2025

Tender RFT 02-25/26 for the Cunderdin Court Surface Replacement is currently open with recent contractor site inspections completed.

Works contracts have been awarded for the site decommissioning, shed construction as well as plumbing, power and lighting works.

Works are expected to start at the end of November, after a shortened basketball season.



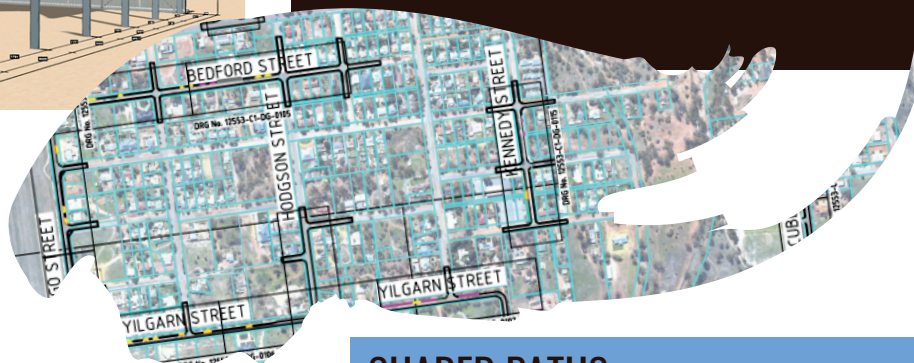
CUNDERDIN MEMORIAL AQUATIC & COMMUNITY WELLNESS HUB

Thank you to all the community members who have taken part in our Aquatic & Wellness Hub surveys. We have received plenty of feedback and are in the process of incorporating the feedback into our designs.

Currently the shire is working with professions to finalise the aquatic and hydrology designs and reports, as well as the hub concept and layout designs.

Once these designs are completed, we'll progress to tender preparation.

The construction of the new cricket practice nets at the Cunderdin oval is nearing completion, and we're excited to see this fantastic facility so close to being ready for use!



SLIDE - O'CONNOR PARK

After a long wait, we have finally received the spare part for the broken slide. Installation is planned for in the next couple of weeks.



The bushfire preparedness water tanks project at the Cunderdin Airfield is progressing well with tank installation completed. These tanks should be ready for the upcoming fire season.

This project has been made possible through the National Water Grid Connections Partnership Project with Department of Water & Environmental Regulation.

SHARED PATHS

Due to the impacts of the wet season, progress on the Shared Path Project has been delayed. In addition, the Shire is working closely with relevant authorities regarding the NBN rollout in town, which is influencing both the location of the paths and construction timelines.

More information will be shared soon regarding the Mitchell & Forrest Street timelines of the project.

Design planning for the remainder of the shared path network — including Lundy, Bedford, Baxter, Kennedy, Togo, Olympic, Cubbine, Hodgson, Watts and Yilgarn Streets — is currently underway and are planned to be delivered over the next four years.

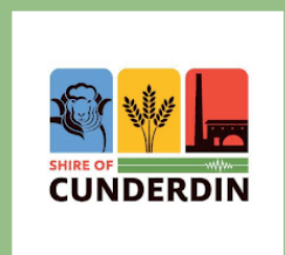
