NOVEMBER 2025

SHARED PATH -MITCHELL & FORREST STREET

The Shire of Cunderdin would like to inform the community that the Shared Path Project on Mitchell & Forrest Street has been temporarily delayed to allow for NBN fibre cable installation.

We are working closely with NBN contractors to develop a timeline and coordinated works program for these roads, ensuring the installation is prioritised and completed as efficiently as possible.

This pause will help prevent potential damage to the new paths during the NBN works. Once the cable installation is completed, the shared path project will resume as planned.

CRICKET PRACTICE NETS




We're excited to announce the completion of our cricket practice nets project!

We have already met with some contractors for a site visit and await tender submissions for works. The anticipated timeline for works to commence is mid-2026. More details to come after tender

WEATHERGUARD COURT PROJECT

This project will commence shortly, as we await the completion of the shortened basketball season. Our first works planned for mid/end of November include the demolishment of the current lights and court surface, as well as the subsurface preparation.

As we move forward with the demolition and improvement works in the area, we kindly ask everyone to stay clear of the works zone for your safety and to allow our teams to complete the project efficiently.

Please also note that basketball poles, seating, and other equipment are not for public removal or reuse. These items will be reinstalled and repurposed around town as part of our community improvement plans.
