COUNCIL MEETING

Highlights



Ordinary Meetings of Council are held on the fourth Wednesday of each month, (excluding January and December, in which the meeting is held on the third Wednesday due to the Christmas period). Meetings commence at 6pm in the Shire's Council Chambers located at the Administration Office. Council receive reports and recommendations, covering a range of topics crucial to the development and governance of the Shire. Following are a summary items recently deliberated by Council:

May 2025

Shire of Cunderdin Meeting Dates for 2025/2026:

Council has endorsed and accepted the Council and Committee Meetings dates and times for the 2025/2026 financial year as presented. Meeting details will be advertised on the Shire of Cunderdin website.

Receive Minutes of the Wheatbelt East Regional Organisation of Councils:

Council received and endorse the Minutes of the Wheatbelt East Regional Organisation of Councils (WEROC) Meeting held on Wednesday 7th May 2025. Discussion points focussed on the housing survey responses and report, coordinating and funding of water plans for all councils in preparation of grant applications and the review of governance structures in each council along with policies and procedures.

Regulatory Signage – Leeming Road/Vanzetti Street Intersection:

Council agreed to request to the Traffic Management Services Manager that a give way sign be installed at on the intersection from Stewart Vanzetti Street to Leeming Road.

Conduct of 2025 Local Government Election

Local Government Elections are due to be held in October 2025. Council were asked to consider how they would like to conduct the elections. It was decided that the Shire Administration will conduct the 2025 local government elections inhouse as an in person election according to section 4.61 of the Local Government Act and that the CEO will be appointed as the returning officer.

Watts Street Subdivision

Advice has been received stating that it will be at least six months before designs will be received and approved by Western Power for the preliminary subdivision designs for the Watts Street land. Following this process a number of different works processes will then need to be tendered prior to commencing site works.

Mitchell Street and Yilgarn Street Housing Update

Construction of the dwelling on Yilgarn Street is progressing quickly with the external brick walls and internal stud walls erected, the windows and frames have been installed and the roof trusses are in place. Modular WA have delivered two dwellings to the Mitchell Street locations. Fencing and landscaping processes will commence over the coming weeks.
