PROJECTS UPDATE

AUGUST 2026

SHARED PATHS - FORREST & MITCHELL STREET

We apologise to the community for the delay to the shared path project on Forrest & Mitchell Street, and thank you for your patience and understanding while the Shire worked through issues with the previous contractor.

The contract has now been terminated, and a Request for Quote (RFQ) has been released for the outstanding works. Once a new contractor has been appointed, we will be able to provide a clearer project timeline and expected completion date.

We appreciate the community's continued patience and will provide further updates as the project progresses.

SHARED PATHS - KENNEDY, BEDFORD, LUNDY & PART OF BAXTER

The previous works contract has been terminated, and a new Public Tender has been released for the construction of the shared paths on Kennedy, Bedford, Lundy and part of Baxter. Once a new contractor has been appointed, we will be able to provide further details on the project timeline and expected completion date.

We appreciate the community's patience and will provide further updates as the project progresses.

CUNDERDIN MEMORIAL AQUATIC & COMMUNITY WELLNESS HUB

Works are slowly continuing on the Aquatic and Wellness Project, with good progress made on site and behind the scenes.

The leisure pool excavation has been completed, along with subsurface drainage and the compacted sand base.

We are currently in a hold pattern while the aquatic contractor finalises the pool designs, which will then be submitted to the Department of Health for approval. As a result, we are expecting a delay to the pool opening. Further details on the revised timeline will be available once pool construction recommences and we have a clearer indication of the construction program. If a delay extends into the warmer months, the Shire is exploring alternative options for the community. More information will be provided as plans progress.

Planning approval has also been received for the Wellness Hub and Kiosk. We are waiting for the 'Issue for Construction Designs', which will be followed with subsurface and footing works. These works are expected to commence in approximately four weeks, weather permitting. We are excited to see works progressing on this part of the project!



SHARED PATH - CUBBINE, WATTS & PART OF TOGO

At a Special Council Meeting held on 5 August 2026, Council considered the tender submissions received for RFT 07-25/26 Shared Paths - Cubbine, Watts and part of Togo. Council has awarded the works contract, with works expected to commence shortly.

WEATHERGUARD COURT PROJECT

The Weatherguard Court Project is currently on hold while we wait for warmer weather to return.

This will enable us to complete the remaining works which includes the installation of the netball and basketball poles, as well as the rubberised sports surface. The rubberised sport surface requires warm overnight temperatures to be installed correctly.

We anticipate these works will commence in early October, with the project expected to be completed in time for the upcoming basketball season.

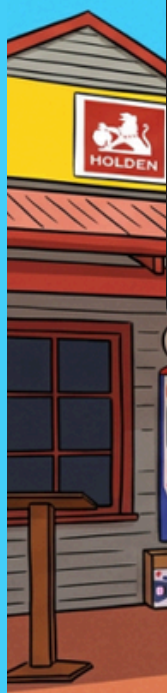
