John Idland – Meckering put forth their vote on the situation, if we notify everyone on the WhatsApp it is helpful for everyone. Everyone knows what is going on, if we go to BART we can use WhatsApp as a notifying platform, BART is good for this as well.

David Beard – Harvests Banned – if the fire danger rating is over 30, Ash, Ben and I weren't working to that. I have opposed that. Soon as a fore is reported a Harvest ban should go on. Units are attending a fire. What we deicide is that the harvest ban should be removed. I would like that policy to be change, this will have to go to council to get that recommendations to be done Todd Harris – assessing the fire and

David Beard -Motion to have the FBI over 30 to be removed from the shire of Cunderdin police – Regulation 38AA. Motion not passed.

Digby – been captain it is very hard to have our truck to move when there is a fire south of the highway. When neighbouring towns don't put a ban on is hard. Tammin are doing well. John Idland – Dave has stepped down from DCBFCO – congratulations on your work, we did have a person put their hand up. Allan Mills-Heath has put his hand up to replace that.

Todd Harris – there has been a recommendation to move the permit to 14days.
