Planning for the new Cunderdin Health Centre – The Schematic Design User Group has developed the floor plan of the new health centre. The final floor plan is being prepared by the architects for circulation to the Project User Group for feedback.

The next phase of design is due to commence in June and involves planning the furniture, fittings and equipment in each room.

Health Services - Computerised X-ray is now available in Cunderdin. Nurse operators are currently being trained to x-ray patients in emergency situations.

Transport – The PUG heard from St John Ambulance's Community Paramedic and a local volunteer to hear of local activity and new services introduced – including the second helicopter and Patient Transport Service.

Aged Accommodation – The Shire of Cunderdin informed the PUG they were successful obtaining a grant to provide Aged Accommodation in Cunderdin. A separate project working group will be formed for the Aged Accommodation Project.
